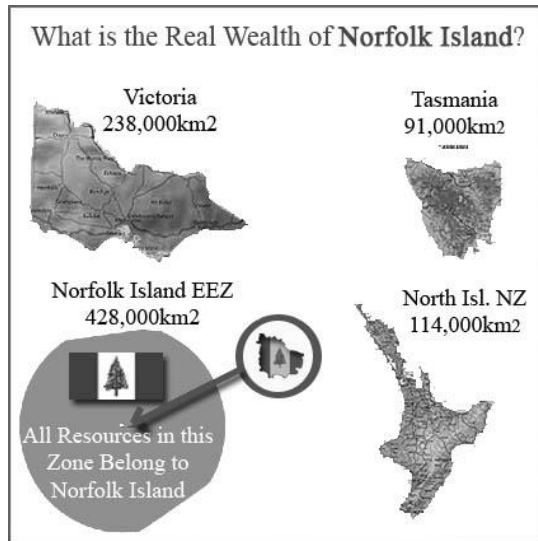




Norfolk Island People for Democracy



The Norfolk Island Exclusive Economic Zone (NIEEZ) is the area of water that extends 200 Nautical miles from the coast of Norfolk Island, in every direction, and includes all of the resources in & under it. The Norfolk Island EEZ is more than 4 times larger than Tasmania, 3 times larger than the North Island of New Zealand and almost twice as large as Victoria. The Norfolk Island EEZ has the potential to generate substantial wealth for the Norfolk Island Community; wealth that could and should be used to support a business case for a sustainable future for the Norfolk Island Community. This model has been proven to work extremely well in the Falklands to the financial benefit of both Britain and the Falkland Island People.

It is of interest to read the speech of the Hon. Bob Ellicott QC in the Federal Parliament on 5 April 1979:

“Again, fishing off Norfolk Island is of some significance, but its pursuit does entail international obligations which, as Honourable members will recall, are negotiated under the Law of the Sea Conventions. They are matters that must be negotiated by the Australian Government but, basically, the fishing around Norfolk Island will be conducted, one hopes, for the benefit of the people of the Island. I repeat, there must always be, as a matter of policy, some acknowledgement of the fact that the conducting of that fishing must fit in with the overall policy upon which the Australian Government, as the international representative, has agreed with other countries.” *(Hansard (Cth) 5th April, 1979 - Page 1644)*

A Special General Meeting is to be held in mid November to formally incorporate the Norfolk Island People for Democracy (NIPD) and to have free and fair elections for the NIPD management committee.
